Woodmen Life Chapter 462 to unveil seven historic markers to commemorate the 175th anniversary of the opening of the Northern Railroad in the autumn of 1850

Woodmen Life Chapter 462, working with the seven Clinton County communities involved, has purchased seven historic markers to commemorate the 175th anniversary of the opening of the Northern Railroad in the autumn of 1850. Later known as the Ogdensburg & Lake Champlain (O&LC) and lastly, the Rutland, the railroad connected the Great Lakes to Lake Champlain and beyond --- on into Vermont and down to Boston.

Unveilings will take place on September 27 at the following times:

- Ellenburg Depot 10 a.m., Station Hill Road
- Altona 11 a.m., Station Street
- Mooers Forks Noon, Blackman Corners Road
- Mooers 1 p.m., Maple Street
- Champlain Village 2 p.m., Prospect Street
- Rouses Point 3 p.m., Montgomery Street.
