Finance Report for the year 2011

You will see in your program an amended report for the year 2010. When preparing the report for 2011 we found a math error for 2010. We have corrected the error and all figures are now correct.

2011 was really a very good year financially, even though we ended with a deficit of \$251. Many of the expenses were one time only expenses related to the opening of the museum. All monies from the donation box were turned over to the Town of Chesterfield to help cover expenses. We had one fundraiser (the First Annual Celebration) that was very successful.

In 2012 we have signed a new Memorandum of Understanding with the Town of Chesterfield. We will now keep all monies from the donation box. We will also pay the telephone/internet bill and cover all cleaning expenses. The Town covered these expenses last year. These changes are truly to our benefit!

We have 2 major fundraisers planned so far this year. We will participate in the Street Drive in Plattsburgh on July 28th. We are sponsoring the Freedom Festival of Music in August. We need help to make these fundraisers successful!

We anticipate another excellent, busy season at the Museum. We also anticipate that the gift shop will show an even greater profit than last year!
