The Whitney Plantation museum is devoted to slavery in the American South. It was opened as a museum in 2014.

The talk will be held at 7:00 pm at St. John's Episcopal Church in Essex, NY. There will be a wine and cheese reception at 6:00 in Persell Hall at St. John's.
